

ST. PAUL'S SCHOOL

School Uniform Policy 3.1

Rationale

All the students attending St Paul's School are expected to wear a neat and tidy regulation uniform as set down by the Board of Trustees.

Purpose

- 1. To draw attention to the Special Character of St Paul's School Massey as a Catholic School.
- 2. To be an equaliser with respect to students' dress code.

Guidelines

- 1. Students with non-regulation uniform are expected to provide an explanation from their parents or guardians and within reasonable time fulfil the uniform requirements.
- 2. All students clothing shall be clearly labelled with student's name.
- 3. The Board of Trustees reserves the right to dispose of any unclaimed clothes from the school lost property box at the end of each school year.
- 4. Sun hats must be worn during breaks in Term 1 and 4 when sunshade is necessary.
- 5. So that a high standard of uniform may be maintained, only the official uniform from St Paul's School Uniform Shop can be worn.
- 6. Uniforms are not to be purchased from other outlets or handmade.
- 7. Years 5 and 6 students must wear the St Paul's Physical Education Shirt during all fitness, physical education and sporting events.
- 8. Used uniform items are available from the St Paul's Uniform Shop.
- 9. In cases of hardship, parents are encouraged to see the Principal.

Uniform for St Paul's School

The official uniform is only available from St Paul's School Uniform Shop. Only the official uniform may be worn. For a description of the St Paul's School Uniform and uniform rules, please refer to the attachment.

Conclusion

St Paul's School Uniform

All children are requested to wear the prescribed school uniform as a condition of enrolment at the school.

Girls

Navy blue culottes/skort

Boys

Navy blue shorts

All Students

- Light blue short or long sleeved polo shirt embroidered with the school name.
- Navy blue jumper embroidered with school name.
- Navy blue polar fleece jacket embroidered with school name.
- Blue school hat.
- > Students must wear sturdy black school shoes with school uniform socks or sandals. No high heels, jandals or boots. Footwear must be black only and kept clean and polished.
- > Children and Parents will be advised by the Principal or staff if their uniform, including footwear, does not comply with the current uniform policy.

Uniform Rules

- > No boxer shorts to be visible (no low-riding)
- > No coloured tee-shirts to be visible under the uniform
- No jumpers or jackets tied around the waist.
- Navy Blue uniform socks to be worn.
- Sunhats to be worn in terms 1 and 4.
 Shoulder length hair MUST be tied back. Hair accessories to be blue or black only.
- Nail Varnish and make-up is not permitted.

For safety reasons the only jewellery permitted are plain small ear studs.

The St Paul's School Uniform Shop is housed in the school hall and is open on Monday and Friday mornings from 8.15am to 8.45am approximately.
