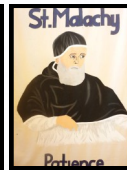

St Dominic's Day

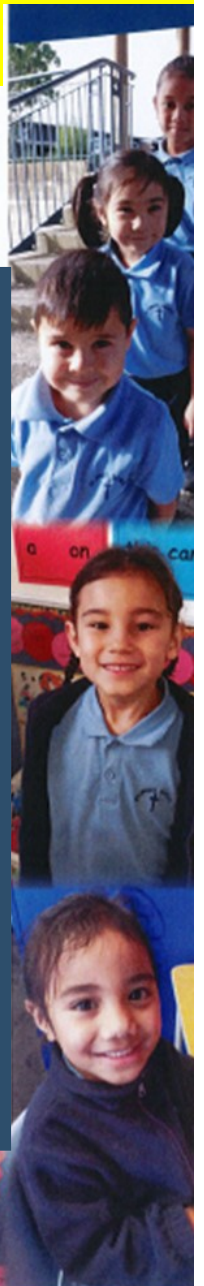
Today we are celebrating the Feast of St Dominic. Dominic is one of our Whānau groups.

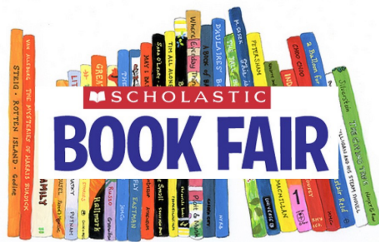
