St Paul's School Massey provides quality education for children in a Catholic community committed to Gospel Values.

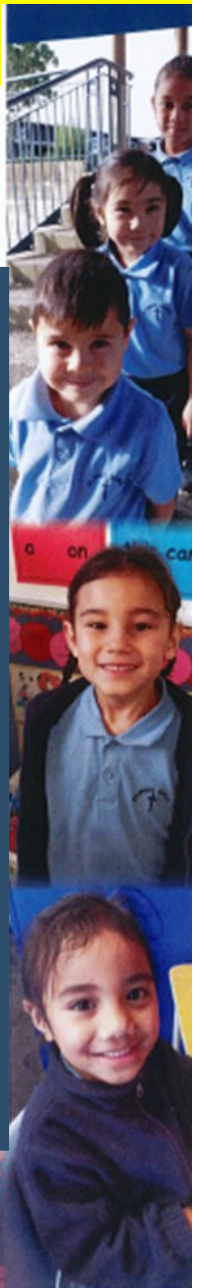


## St Mary MacKillop

Yesterday, we celebrated the Feast of St Mary MacKillop. MacKillop is one of our Whānau groups.

Mary MacKillop was born 15 January 1842 in Australia. She founded Australia's first order of nuns, the Sisters of St Joseph of the Sacred Heart or Josephites. Mary believed in providing free education to all children and set up the first school for children in an outback area in South Australia. More schools were established, including in New South Wales and New Zealand. The order also started an orphanage, a refuge for women and a home for the aged.

The Josephite Order was devoted to education and charity. She died on the 8th August 1909.
