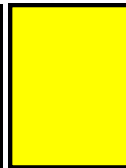

St Paul's School Massey provides quality education for children in a Catholic community committed to Gospel Values.



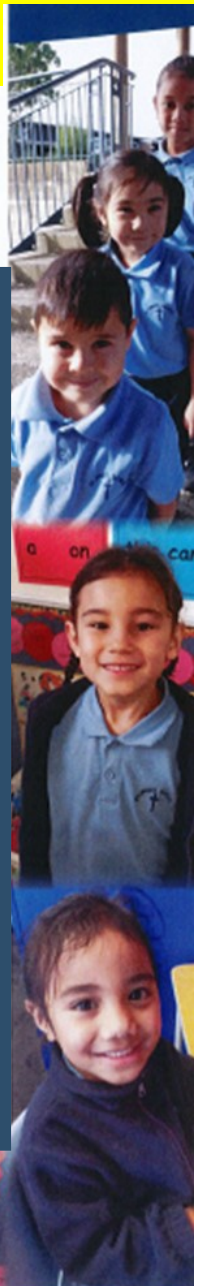
At last Sunday's Mass, the Thirtieth Week of Ordinary Time, the Gospel reading was from Matthew 22: 34-40.
