Kia ora everyone,

Over the last two weeks I have been conducting interviews with families wanting to enrol their child in our school. I always ask the children if their parents read to them. Most of the children say yes. This is great to hear.

Reading aloud to young children is a great way of enjoying books together. Parents, try to set aside a short period each day for reading to your children. Choose a quiet time that your children know is especially for them, for instance, before they go to sleep. Allow your children to choose favourite stories but introduce new ones too. Often, children are very interested in the books that you liked as a child. Sit close to your children when you read

to them, holding the books so they can see it. Take time to look at the pictures.

Why not let the children see you reading—for enjoyment, for news etc.

By Years 5 and 6, if students want to make year appropriate progress they should be reading 1.1 million words a year outside school. This is equivalent to 25 to 35 books. This should take about 15-30 minutes each night.

So keep reading.
