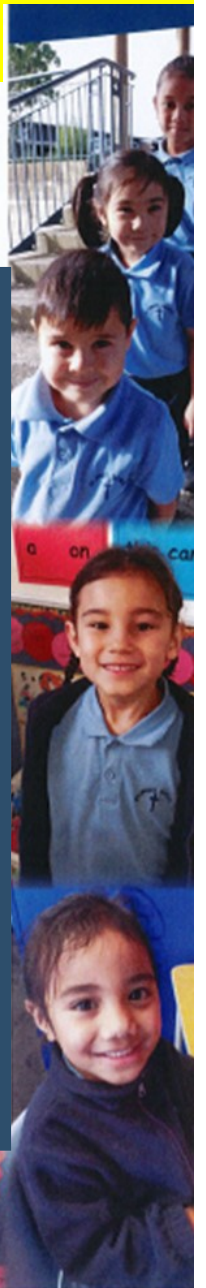


Prayer for peace in the Holy Land

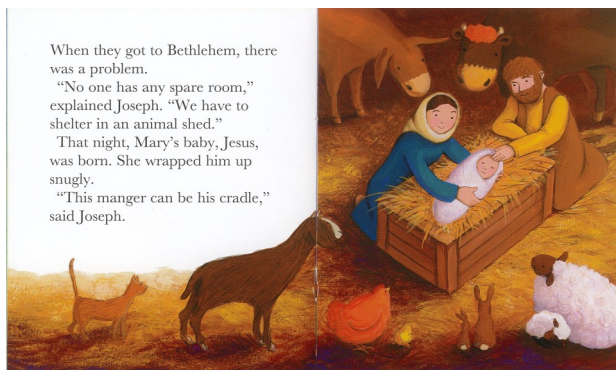
