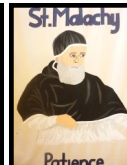

St Paul's School Massey provides quality education for children in a Catholic community committed to Gospel Values.



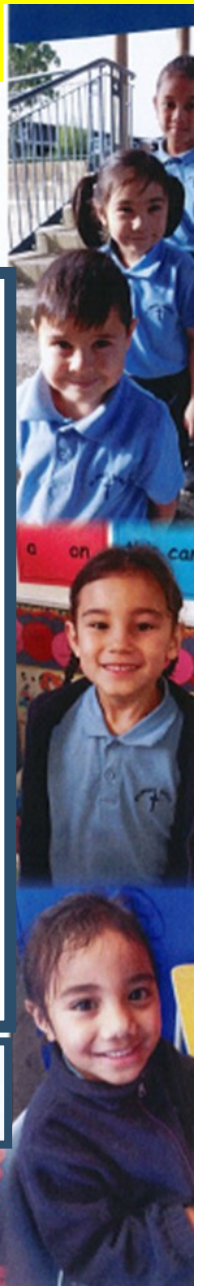
**Last Sunday was the 3rd Sunday of Lent.
