St Paul's School Massey provides quality education for children in a Catholic community committed to Gospel Values.




















The use of the term Ordinary Time in our liturgical calendar distinguishes it from the other seasons—Advent, Christmas, Lent and Easter—which


focus on particular aspects of Christ's life: his birth, suffering, death and resurrection. Ordinary Time celebrates Jesus' teaching and ministry.


