Math-a-Thon

Last Friday I spoke to all the children about our Math-a-thon. We are encouraging our children to learn the basic facts (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). They will bring home the level they need to learn. The answers need to be recalled immediately, so totally memorized. This will help them with more complicated maths problems.
