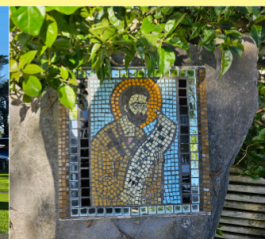

Baptism Programme

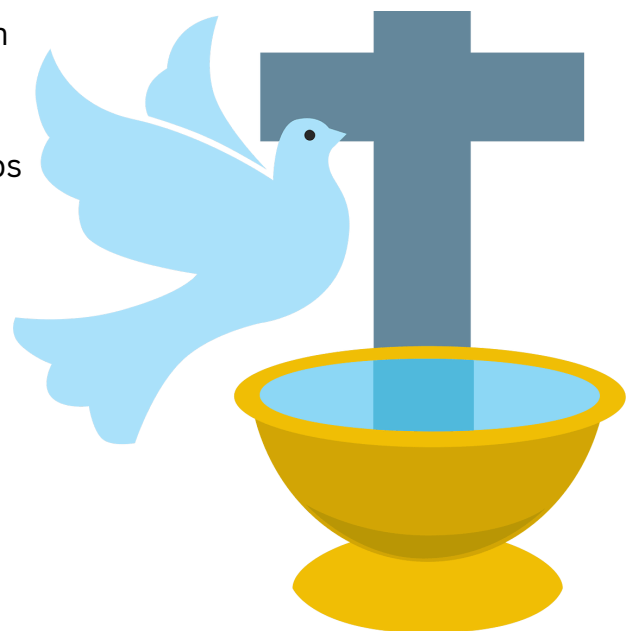
Our core vision is for our students to have a living knowledge of the Catholic Faith. The first step on this journey of faith development is for your child to receive the Sacrament of Baptism.

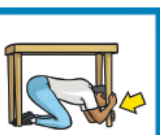
