November is a special month in the Catholic Church. It begins with All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day, and the whole month is dedicated to remembering and praying for people who have died.

The Church teaches that some people, called the Holy Souls, are in Purgatory. These are people who loved God and tried to live good lives but still need to be made completely ready to be with God in Heaven. During November, we pray for our loved ones who have died - family members, friends, and even people we may not know. Some souls might not have anyone to pray for them, so our prayers can be a special gift to them.

When we pray for the Holy Souls, we are reminded that we are all part of one big family of believers - people in Heaven, people in Purgatory, and people here on Earth. One day, those we pray for might be able to pray for us, too!

Pope Saint John XXIII once said, "The devotion to the memory of the dead is one of the most beautiful expressions of the Catholic spirit."


