Armistice Day

On the 11th of November 1918, the First World War ended. Every year on this day, we pause to remember all the men and women who have served in wars, peacekeeping missions, and times of conflict. At 11 o'clock, people around the world stop for a minute of silence to pray and give thanks for their courage and sacrifice.

As a Catholic school, we remember that peace is a gift from God. Jesus said, "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God." (Matthew 5:9) When we pray for peace, we are asking God to help us be kind, fair, and forgiving – people who build a world where everyone is safe and cared for. The white crosses on our lawn remind us of those who gave their lives for others. Parents and families are most welcome to visit the crosses, take a moment to pray quietly for peace in our world today, and to thank God for those who worked to bring peace in the past.

we thank You for the gift of peace.

Help us to remember with gratitude

those who gave their lives for others.

Teach us to be peacemakers in our families, our school, and our world.

We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
