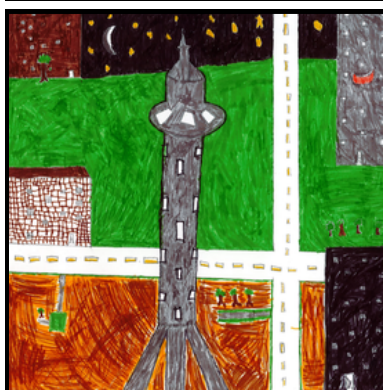
Celebrating Our Former Students' Art at Auckland's New Te Waihorotiu Station!
